Dump truck we sold to Eddie Baldwin has exempt plates on it. Are they ours? If so, we need them back. Motion to spend \$120.00/year for domain name through Network Solutions made by Brooke, seconded by Scotty, carried. We have received a training burn permit, number FF182. Notifications should be made to Northwestern Energy, Forest Service, Highway department before the department conducts their planned training burn.
